Humpty Dumpty

We learned the words to the rhyme and each child shared their own idea of why Humpty Dumpty fell off the wall. During our gym time we practiced our throwing skills during a Humpty Dumpty Egg Toss game.

Jesus Time

This month we read the story *The Wise Men Visit Jesus*. We read how God put a special star in the sky when Jesus was born and how Wise Men followed that star to Bethlehem to find and worship Jesus. (Matthew 2:1-12)



Rub a Dub Dub

We learned the rhyme and then we did a sink or float experiment. After making guesses, we investigated what items sank or floated at the water table.

Hickory Dickory Dock

We practiced number recognition as each child took a turn acting out the rhyme. First they picked a number on a toy clock, and then they followed to directions to complete the rhyme.



Jack Be Nimble

We learned the rhyme and then went to the gym to practice jumping at different stations. We practiced hopping, leaping, jumping off, jumping over, and even jumping high on a trampoline.

Itsy Bitsy Spider

After learning the rhyme, the children were given a choice of what project they wanted to do including making a clay spider, drawing a spider, and lacing a spider web.

Handwriting Without Tears

The students were introduced to using wooden curves and lines to build Mat Man and make capital letters!
