

# **OLD TESTAMENT: DEUTERONOMY 5:12-15**

Be careful to remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy as the LORD your God has commanded you. <sup>13</sup> You are to labor six days and do all your work, <sup>14</sup> but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. Do not do any work—you, your son or daughter, your male or female slave, your ox or donkey, any of your livestock, or the resident alien who lives within your city gates, so that your male and female slaves may rest as you do.

<sup>15</sup> Remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God brought you out of there with a strong hand and an outstretched arm. That is why the LORD your God has commanded you to keep the Sabbath day. (CSB)

### **NEW TESTAMENT: 2 CORINTHIANS 4:5-12**

We are not proclaiming ourselves but Jesus Christ as Lord, and ourselves as your servants for Jesus's sake. <sup>6</sup> For God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of God's glory in the face of Jesus Christ.

<sup>7</sup>Now we have this treasure in clay jars, so that this extraordinary power may be from God and not from us. <sup>8</sup>We are afflicted in every way but not crushed; we are perplexed but not in despair; <sup>9</sup>we are persecuted but not abandoned; we are struck down but not destroyed. <sup>10</sup>We always carry the death of Jesus in our body, so that the life of Jesus may also be displayed in our body. <sup>11</sup>For we who live are always being given over to death for Jesus's sake, so that Jesus's life may also be displayed in our mortal flesh. <sup>12</sup>So then, death is at work in us, but life in you. (CSB)

# THE HOLY GOSPEL: MARK 2:23 - 3:1-5

The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> chapters.

On the Sabbath Jesus was going through the grainfields, and his disciples began to make their way, picking some heads of grain. <sup>24</sup> The Pharisees said to him, "Look, why are they doing what is not lawful on the Sabbath?"

<sup>25</sup> He said to them, "Have you never read what David and those who were with him did when he was in need and hungry — <sup>26</sup> how he entered the house of God in the time of Abiathar the high priest and ate the bread of the Presence —which is not lawful for anyone to eat except the priests —and also gave some to his companions?" <sup>27</sup> Then he told them, "The Sabbath was made for man and not man for the Sabbath. <sup>28</sup> So then, the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."

Jesus entered the synagogue again, and a man was there who had a shriveled hand. <sup>2</sup> In order to accuse him, they were watching him closely to see whether he would heal him on the Sabbath. <sup>3</sup> He told the man with the shriveled hand, "Stand before us." <sup>4</sup> Then he said to them, "Is it lawful to do good on the Sabbath or to do evil, to save life or to kill?" But they were silent. <sup>5</sup> After looking around at them with anger, he was grieved at the hardness of their hearts and told the man, "Stretch out your hand." So he stretched it out, and his hand was restored. (*CSB*)


