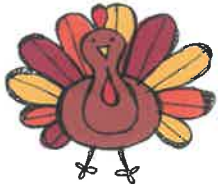


# Look at What We are Learning!!!

## Pumpkins

We explored pumpkins through math and science! We weighed a pumpkin, estimated how many seeds were inside, predicted if a pumpkin would sink or float, and took out all the pumpkin guts!

## Apples

We learned about how apples grow, the different parts of an apple, we painted with apples, we tasted and graphed our favorite apple color and we made applesauce.

## Fall Patterns

The children chose different color, shape, and size fall stickers to make patterns. As they manipulated the stickers, they practiced color recognition, size recognition, and pattern sequencing.

## Jesus Time

This month we read the story of *The Man Who Said Thank You*. From this story, we learned how happy it makes Jesus when we are thankful for all the many things He has blessed us with in our lives! Ask your child to share the story with you!!
