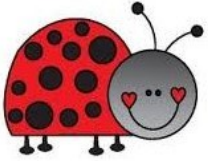
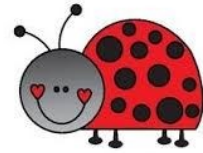


Look At What We are Learning!

Many of our activities this month grew from Our Color Days Project. We wore the color of the day, created a color poster with items from home, heard a color story, played with loose parts of that color, and created a page in our Color Song Book. Nature walks helped us find those colors outdoors.



We painted with cotton swabs, dot markers, brushes, and carrots! We colored with chalk, crayons and sandpaper. We attached things with white glue, glue sticks and tape. We even made grass by cutting with scissors. We read, counted and sang our way through each numbered page. Our fingers and hands and minds sure got lots of exercise and practice with all that creating! We even explored, drew and painted sunflowers!
