Dear Brothers and Sisters,

May 10<sup>th</sup> will be our first Sunday back in the auditorium for Sunday Morning Worship. This day is incredibly special in that reason itself; however, it is extra special because it is also Mother's Day. First, I want to wish every Mother a "Happy Mother's Day."

I want to share with you what you can expect should you decide to come to the church building for worship services on Sunday morning. Please remember that we are trying to accommodate as many people as we can yet maintain a safe environment. We will do our best to follow the recommended guidelines suggested by Federal, State, and local governments and do what seems reasonable.

- 1. Please try to arrive to the building a little earlier that you normally do. Arriving five minutes earlier would be very helpful in order to start on time.
- 2. All members will enter through the front doors only. All other entries will be locked.
- 3. There will be markers on the sidewalks and inside the church building indicating six foot spacing. Please do your best to practice "social distancing" which has been in effect for several weeks now.
- 4. There will be a number of ushers who will guide you once you get inside the building.
- 5. We will be seating people in a systematic way in order to maximize the space we have accommodated.
- 6. VERY IMPORTANT: It is highly unlikely you will be sitting in the pew you normally would be in. We will not be able to save seats nor will family or friends be able to save seats for you. The reason is we have to seat people in a certain order for us to be able to maintain the "6 feet" rule.
- 7. Still very important: We will sit families and couples together provided they enter into the building together. Therefore, ride together or make arrangements to meet in the parking lot. If you are single, you will be seated with 6 feet between you and the next person. However, if you want to sit with one of your friend(s) and you have mutually agreed to do so, please enter the building together as stated above.

As you can see there are a lot of moving parts and we (ushers) have never done this. Therefore, we ask for patience and understanding.

Remember, the purpose of being in the building together is not to sit in a certain spot or by a certain person. The purpose is to serve and worship our God.

Please continue to pray the virus will pass quickly and we can come to worship services again just like the "good ole days"!!
