

Family Buckets for Ukraine

Family buckets filled with daily necessities have met the needs of refugees in other situations over a number of years. These 5-gallon painter-grade buckets with lids not only store items but protect them from the elements -- and act as a temporary stool when traveling from place to place.

Each bucket should be filled with ALL the items listed below. Additional small items can be added as space allows.

THE BUCKET LIST:

- □ 3 hand towels --- thin is best
- Silverware -fork, spoon, knife X 4 (used acceptable)
- □ 1 box kitchen matches
- 1 food storage container (Gladware, etc.)
- Paring knives X 2
- □ 1 strainer bowl (optional)
- □ 1 cutting board or mat (flexible OK)
- 1 bottle antibacterial hand soap (personal size)
- □ 1 pair adult scissors
- □ 1 bottle Dawn dish soap 24 oz size
- Band aids and antibiotic ointment
- 1 stick men's deodorant (Speed Stick, etc.)
- 1 stick women's deodorant (Lady Speed Stick)
- □ 1 tube toothpaste (not travel size)
- □ 3 packs of two-count toothbrushes
- 1 box emergency (long-burn) candles, 3 hours or more

□ 1 clothes-line rope

- 1 bottle shampoo (Suave, White Rain)
- 2 bars bath soap (i.e. Dial, Irish Spring, etc.)
- □ 1 pack of 4 scouring pads
- 1 vegetable cleaning brush
- □ 1 scrubbing brush with handle
- □ 1 set of 2 square pot holders
- □ 1 hand grater (optional)
- □ 4 coffee mugs (used or plastic OK)
- Other small items to fill empty space, i.e. spiral note pads and pens, small flashlights, lip balm, small packs of Kleenex, coloring books and crayons)

NOTE: Dollar Tree, Dollar General and similar stores have many of these items at very low prices.
