Lesson Eight

The Unjust Judge

Scripture Reference: Luke 18:1-8

Memory Verse: "And I say unto you, ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." (Luke 11:9)

"Let's go play baseball, Tom."

"I don't believe I'll go, Andy. Thanks anyway."

"Why not? Come on we'll have lots of fun."

"Maybe you will but Phillip is sure to be there and he'll take all the fun out of it for me. Every time I get near him he jumps on me or teases me. A little of that is not so bad but I sure get tired of that bully. I'm going to talk to Dad about it when he comes home. I don't know what to do about it. He's so much bigger than I am."

Later that afternoon Tom did talk to his Dad.

"Well, son I don't want you to be afraid of bullies. Usually if someone calls their bluff they turn out to be cowards. But Jesus also told us to

love our enemies and do good to them. Have you tried that? It may be hard but I guess it was hard for Jesus to love those who nailed Him to the cross. Jesus also told us to pray to God for help. Have you been praying?"

"Yes, a little, I guess."

"Don't give up too soon. Jesus told a parable to teach us to keep praying. There was a judge who did not believe in God and had no respect for men. But he gave justice to a poor defenseless widow just be-




cause she was so persistent. To keep her from wearing him out with continual pleading he helped the widow. Jesus then pointed out that the just, loving heavenly Father will certainly help us if we are mistreated.

He told another parable showing we should keep praying. In Luke 11:5-13 we are taught to keep on, not to give up."

"But, Dad, why would God let anybody get by with wrong for a long

time?"

"We may not know all the reasons and they may not always be the same. Maybe He wants to give the sinner a chance to repent. Sometimes it does us good to be mistreated. We learn how it can make us more careful not to tease or hurt others. It may make us more patient and appreciate how much we depend on the Lord. Anyway, Tom, try to love the bully. There is something wrong with him or he wouldn't be that way. Pray about it and be patient when he mistreats you. You don't have to stay around him more than you can help. Then if God waits a



long time to answer your prayers that the bully stop bothering you, just remember God does right all wrongs now or later. Then don't give up. Keep praying in faith."
