BAPTISM – The Old Versus The New

Why are we baptized? There are several reasons: Jesus commanded it (Matthew 28:19). The 3,000 who believed at Pentecost, the Gospel's first fruits, were baptized (Acts 2:38). The Samaritans when they received the Gospel, were baptized (Acts 8:12, 16). Saul was baptized (Acts 9:18, 22:16). Cornelius, the first Gentile convert, was baptized (Acts 10:47, 48). Lydia was baptized (Acts 16:15). So was the Philippian jailor (Acts 16:33). And the Corinthians (Acts 18:8). And the Ephesians (Acts 19:5). Paul speaks of baptism as a representation of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus and as our passageway into his death and into the hope of resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:1-4, Romans 6:3-7 and Colossians 2:12). Peter referred to baptism as the connecting point to forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38). Mark said baptism is required to be saved (Mark 16:16). In John 3:3-5, Nicodemus came to Jesus, and he was told that he must be born again to see the kingdom of God (John 3:3). This birth consisted of being born of water and the Spirit (John 3:5). Peter made the connection of baptism and water in 1 Peter 3:21 and Paul and Peter made the connection with baptism and the Spirit in 1 Corinthians 12:13 and Acts 2:38 respectively.

The concept of baptism was not ushered in at the cross. There were many reasons that the Jews under the Old Testament used a form of baptism as a ceremonial washing (Exodus 29:4, 30:20, 40:12, Leviticus 15, 16:26, 17:15, 22:4, Numbers 19:8). In Hebrews 6:2 the writer refers to instructions concerning baptisms. There may have been various reasons the Jewish people baptized but they all seem to be connected to the purification process. Many believe also that in Christ's time, as certainly was the case later, proselytes to Judaism were baptized.

We can be certain that John the Baptist used baptism as a passage to forgiveness. In Mark 1:4 the writer says, "John appeared, baptizing in the wilderness and proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins." Recipients of it thereby acknowledged their sins and professed their faith that through the coming Messiah they would be forgiven.

We can see from the passages above that the idea of baptism was not new to the society of the first century. However, the idea that we are baptized into Christ (Galatians 3:26-27) and into his death (Romans 6:3) and then raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead, is a new concept. Baptism in the Old Testament and during the time of Christ was a ritual that foreshadowed the baptism of the Christian faith. There may have been many other connections between the old and the new, but it would seem important that all understand the importance of baptism in our lives today.
