

Consider the Claims for Jesus (Part 1)

If you were to try to name the problem that bothers people the most, what would it be? Some might say, "a pandemic and its effects." Others might say "having enough to live on" or "fear of failure." Still others might speak about "growing older" or "having enough to live on when I get older." Finally, some might focus on the ever-changing world political situation.

Numerous surveys indicate that many harbor the goal of hoping to "find the meaning of life." This seems to be a recurring theme for many people. We all need purpose for our existence, or else everything we accomplish and acquire becomes meaningless. For this reason, many lose themselves in social work, in medical services, or in some other endeavor that seeks to serve others. Some turn inward, isolating themselves in a monastery or otherwise striving for private meditation or self-contemplation. The common thread through all of these is the desire to find real meaning and purpose in life.

God has made man in His own image. "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness" (Gen. 1:26). Thus, He has the answers which man seeks. We are told, "God, having of old time spoken unto the fathers in the prophets by divers' portions and in divers' manners, hath at the end of these days spoken unto us in his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, through whom also he made the worlds" (Heb. 1:1-2). The theme of the gospel is that God sent His Son as a sacrifice for us, for we are all sinners. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth on him should not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16). He was born of Mary in Bethlehem (Luke 2:4-7), crucified on a cruel cross as a sacrifice for us sinners. "For while we were yet weak, in due season Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die for peradventure for the good man someone would even dare to die. But God commended his own love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Rom. 5:6-8). And it was through Jesus God reveals Himself to man. "I came that they may have life and may have it abundantly" (John 10:10). Jesus came to reveal God to us, and in so doing, He reveals the meaning and purpose of life. Jesus has the answer, gives the answer, and is the answer to life's problems.

Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life: no one cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6). The apostles later said of Jesus, "And in none other is there salvation: for neither is there any other name under heaven, that is given among men, wherein we must be saved.) (Acts 4:12). The apostle Paul wrote that the life and death of Jesus was "according to the eternal purpose of God" (Eph. 3:11). These are all lofty claims, but what is the evidence for them?
