Consider the Claims for Jesus (Part 2)
The Fulfillment of Prophecy

When man first sinned, God told Satan that He would send a Savior. “*And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed: he shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel:*” (Gen. 3:15). From that time there were hundreds of prophecies given that promised a Savior. He was to be “*the seed of Abraham.... Isaac.... Jacob*” (Gen. 22:18, 28:14), of the tribe of Judah (Gen. 49:10), “*the branch of David*” (Jer.23:5), born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14) in the city of Bethlehem (Micha 5:2). He was to be a prophet like Moses (Deut. 18:18), a high priest like Melchizedek (Psalm 110:4), a king like David (Psalm 89:3-4; Jer. 23:5-6). He was to preach to the poor, help the weak, heal the sick, comfort the broken-hearted, and free those in bondage. “*The Spirit of the Lord Jehovah is upon me; because Jehovah hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the year of Jehovah’s favor, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; to appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them a garland for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of Jehovah, that he may be glorified*” (Isaiah 61:1-3). That Jesus, and only Jesus, fulfilled all the prophecies is evident to all who will see.

Jesus was born of a virgin (Matt. 1:23), in the city of Bethlehem (Luke 2:5). He was of the lineage of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah, and David (Matt. 1:2-6). Jesus was preached as the “*prophet like Moses*” (John 12:49; Acts 3:22), and the priest of God like Melchizedek (Heb. 6:20 – 7:3). When he read prophecy in the synagogue at Nazareth, He said plainly, “*Today hath this scripture been fulfilled in your ears*” (Luke 4:21). And the apostle Peter later declared, “*Yea and all the prophets from Samuel and them that followed after, as many as have spoken, they also told of these days*” (Acts 3:24).

The 22nd Psalm reveals the scene of the cross in great detail several centuries before it happened. Isaiah 53 tells of His manner of life, His character, His death, His burial and His purpose on earth. The life of Jesus, with His purposes for living and dying, was predicted with absolute accuracy hundreds of years before He walked this earth. The accurate fulfillment of prophecy established the claims of Jesus.


