Consider the Claims for Jesus (Part 4)

The Miracles of Jesus

On one occasion, while being questioned by the Jews about His authority, Jesus said, *“But I have a greater witness than John’s; for the works which the Father has given Me to Finish - the very works that I do – bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me.”* (John 5:36). He healed the sick (Mark 1:32-34), even including the lepers (Mark 1:40-45), and all the people saw it and knew it.

He stilled the storm, prompting even the apostles to be amazed, “But He said to them, “Why are you fearful, O you of little faith? Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm. So, the men marveled, saying, Who can this be, that even the winds and the sea obey *Him*?” (Matt. 8:26-27). He restored sight to the blind, made the lame to walk and the deaf to hear. He even raised the dead, with many witnesses to testify to these events (Luke 7:11-17), 8:49-56; John 11:17-46). On one occasion, the Jews used a crippled man to attempt to discredit or condemn Jesus. *“So, they watched Him closely, whether He would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him.”* (Mark 3:2). The amazing thing to me is they never questioned whether Jesus had the **POWER** to heal the man. They knew He did and hoped to use it against him!

A ruler of the Jews came to Jesus with the conclusion they all should have had: *“There was a man named Nicodemus. Nicodemus was one of the Pharisees. He was an important Jewish leader. One night Nicodemus came to Jesus. Nicodemus said: Rabbi (teacher), we know that you are a teacher sent from God. No person can do these miracles that you do without God’s help”* (John 3:1-2). That was the real purpose of his miracles, as with the miracles His apostles did later. *“Jesus did many other miracles that his followers saw. Those miracles are not written in this book. But these things are written so that you can believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. Then, by believing, you can have life through his name”.* (John 20:30-31).

When the apostles later performed miracles, by the power which Jesus Christ gave them, it was to prove they were also from God, and thus, to verify their message. *“God also proved it by using wonders, great signs, and many kinds of miracles. And he proved it by giving people gifts through the Holy Spirit. He gave those gifts the way he wanted.* (Heb. 2:4). One such miracle led the Jewish council to try to discredit the apostles, but they plainly stated, *“they said, what shall we do with these men (the apostles)? Every person in Jerusalem knows that they have done a great miracle. This is clear. We cannot say it is not true.* (Acts 4:16). The miracles of Jesus and His apostles certainly substantiate His claims.

Jesus provides the answer to your problems. He gives direction and purpose to your life. He offers you forgiveness and peace in this life. And He offers you eternal salvation. No one else can do it. Man’s purpose is stated thus: *“Now, what should we learn from all the things that are written in this book? The most important thing a person can do is to respect God and obey his commands. Why? Because God knows about all the things people do – even the secret things”* (Eccl. 12:13). Only in Jesus can that purpose be filled. (John 14:6). Consider the claims of Jesus and trust in Him.
