Consider the Claims for Jesus (Part 3)
The Life and Ministry of Jesus

There are three passages which graphically depict the life of Jesus. *The Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many*” (Matt. 20:28). Jesus was a servant (or slave). He served the Father, and He served mankind. He “*went about doing good*” (Acts 10:38). When Joh the Baptist was imprisoned, he sent his followers to inquire of Jesus. “*Now when John heard in the prison the works of the Christ, he sent his disciples and said unto him, Art thou he that cometh, or look we for another? And Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and tell John the things which ye hear and see: the blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good tidings preached to them*” (Matt. 11:2-5). The unselfish life He lived substantiates His claim to be the long awaited Messiah.


The second passage shows why Jesus was such a servant to His fellow man. “*And he came forth and saw a great multitude, and he had compassion on them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things*” (Mark 6:34). Jesus cared. The loneliness, the pain, and the despair of those about Him touched Jesus, and later we are told “*He careth for you*” (1 Peter 5:7).





He forcefully drove the money-changers from the temple, but then He wept over their hardness of heart. “*And the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. And he found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting: and he made a scourge of cords, and cast all out of the temple, both the sheep and the oxen; and he poured out the changers’ money, and overthrew their tables; and to them that sold the doves he said, Take these things hence; make not my Father’s house a house of merchandise. His disciples remembered that it was written, Zeal for thy house shall eat me up...O Jerusalem. Jerusalem, that killeth the prophets, and stoneth them that are sent unto her! How often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!*” (John 2:13-17; Matt. 23:37).

He rebuked His own disciples when they failed to heal a young man. They asked Jesus why they failed. His response was “*Because of your little faith; for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you*” (Matt. 17:20). Yet He then wept with them at the tomb of His good friend, Lazarus (John 11:35). Jesus cared about people, and they knew it due to His miracles. His touch, His concern for those who have little or nothing to offer.
