Verse 7. Noah's faith prepared the ark to save his entire family. He did not say, "I believe God; I put my trust in Him." His faith built the ark.

Verse 8. Abraham's faith went out from Ur. He did not say, "God spoke to me, I heard His voice." His faith moved him a thousand miles from the land of his

Verse 9. Abraham's faith dwelt in tents, and he lived as a sojourner, never again in a house like he could have had in Ur. His faith made him to be a "gypsy." Verse 9. Isaac and Jacob's faith stayed in tents. They could have at any moment returned to the land from which Abraham had come. They stayed

Verses 20-21. Isaac and Jacob's faith blessed their children, knowing God would use them. Faith is not words said, it is action based on obedience, not
