The companionship we can offer God is through worship, assembling with those that worship God (Heb. 10:25). Another form of companionship is through prayer. How often do we pray that is not connected with food? We ought to "always pray and not lose heart" (Luke 18:1). "Always praying" and "without ceasing" are emphasized in Scripture (Eph. 6:1; 1 Thess. 5:17). Companionship can be sought in Scripture, reading and listening to God's

There is a spirit of rejoicing that comes with first entering into a relationship with God (Acts 8:39; 16:34). We see that in new converts, but has our rejoicing waned? "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!" (Phil. 4:4).

Can I say that I love the things He loves (1 John 5:3)? Can I say that I hate the things He hates (Prov. 6:16-19). If we love God, then we need to have these

This is a tremendous problem in many relationships. Trust is something that is earned over time. God, throughout all time has proven Himself to be trustworthy. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not lean on your own

understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight" (Prov. 3:5-6). "Have faith in God" (Mark 11:22).

"Each one must do just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Cor. 9:7). Some have chosen to rob God (Mal. **3:8**).
