I wonder how many churches of Christ there are today like the church in Sardis. Maybe a church has great attendance, lots of programs of work, a big budget and activity going on daily. All of this is good, and we would say, "That church is really alive." But is it possible the Lord would pronounce that church dead, just as Sardis was? Christ looks at the spiritual strength of a church, not just the numbers. And outward actions do not always reflect spiritual conditions. A church can have a good reputation, like Sardis, and still be dead. But what can cause a church to die? How can the spiritual

strength of a congregation diminish to the point of vanishing? What are some of the factors that lead to the spiritual death of a congregation of the Lord? Let us take the time to examine what causes churches to die. ~ Clem Thurman



What Causes Churches to Die? (Part 1 of 6)

Jesus instructed the apostle John to write to the church of Sardis in the first century, "I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and thou art dead" (Rev. 3:1). Very little is revealed to us about the church in Sardis. We don't know what their budget was, what their attendance was to their various worship assemblies, and we know nothing of their building (if they even had one). Nothing is said about who their preacher was, how many elders they had and if they had any debts. All of those good things that we use to "measure" a church today were not revealed. They had a good reputation, "Though hast a name that thou livest." But Jesus told them, "Though art dead." They evidently thought they were doing fine, but the Lord knew better. They had died without
