What Causes Churches to Die? (Part 6 of 6)

Lack of Evangelism

To have spiritual life with Christ and to dwell with Him eternally, we must learn to obey and teach His word. As the church, the "called out," we must have concern for the needs of those around us. And this is most especially true when it comes to evangelism. The Lord's command remains. *"Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit"* (Matt. 28:19-20). This can be done in countless ways, beginning with a simple invitation to a neighbor to attend worship with you. The sad truth is that, if we fail to spread the good news, the church will die. And we cannot spread it unless we are willing to take a step of faith and share the gospel with our friends and neighbors who have little or no knowledge of Jesus.

Seeking first God's approval, the church must separate from the world. *"and be not fashioned according to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, and ye may prove what is good and acceptable and perfect will of God."* (Rom. 12:2). It is thus that we can *"give the more diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never stumble"* (2 Peter 1:10). The church that doesn't care enough to learn His will and show concern for others will surely die.
