We wanted to take a minute to bring everyone up to speed on another part of our Food Pantry Ministry. We recognized that there was a need to help many families in the Collinsville Area due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Thanks to the efforts of those who went shopping and donated food or money, those who sacked food, and all the folks who manned the drive through lanes, we were able to feed 47 families in Collinsville. The Lord has a way of giving us the "open door" to minister to those around us if we only look for the opportunity. We are so thankful to everyone who gave of themselves, their time and resources to make this happen. God has been good to us here in Collinsville. Here are a few things the Elders would like to share with you about this effort in our Food Pantry Ministry:

- We are planning to feed 50 families a week.
- This will cost roughly 2800.00 dollars a week.
- We would like to do this on a weekly basis until everyone goes back to work.
- We have received positive signs of support from local businesses.
- The monthly budget for benevolence is 600.00 a month.
- We need everyone to continue to make their regular contributions to support the work of the church already established and if you are able, to donate to this ministry as well.
- The church has established a separate account for donations and expenses to support the Food Pantry Ministry.
- Please support the ministry however you can, but do not put you or your families in jeopardy of financial risk. This is a ministry that is being used to support families, but this is not to endanger our family.
- We will hand out food as long as possible to assist these families in need.

Your support has been tremendous. God has helped us reach several families. We are giving out leaflets in the bags of food which give the families who receive the food contact information for the church. This program is meant to feed the families both physically and spiritually. Please help us reach as many souls as possible.
