Last week Patty Roberts sent me a copy of a Whitesboro newspaper article written by George Henry Stephenson announcing the grand opening (January 12, 1984) of the Collinsville church of Christ's new building. It had been a twelve-year dream to build this building and it is described well. All the community was invited, and a gospel meeting ran from Sunday to Wednesday. Last Sunday (January 14) was the 40th anniversary of that grand opening. Can you believe we have been worshiping in this building for forty years.
