Last week Patty Roberts sent me a copy of a Whitesboro newspaper article written by George Henry Stephenson announcing the grand opening (January 12, 1984) of the Collinsville church of Christ’s new building. It had been a twelve-year dream to build this building and it is described well. All the community was invited, and a gospel meeting ran from Sunday to Wednesday. Last Sunday (January 14) was the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of that grand opening. Can you believe we have been worshipping in this building for forty years. To many it may seem like yesterday when you came to worship for the first time in this building. The church has continued to remain strong and has grown through the years.

It made me think about the state of the Collinsville church forty years from now. Many of us like myself will have gone on to our reward but many of you will remain. 
