The Qualifications of an Elder

Continued from last week

Text: I Timothy 3; Titus 1; I Peter 5:1-4

Domestic Relations

- To be scriptural married, the husband of one wife (Titus 1:6; I Timothy 3:2) This means he is to be married (having a wife; which excludes women from serving as an elder). To be scripturally married means: One that has never been married before; One whose former mate is dead (cf. Romans 7:1-3); One with a scriptural divorce (only for fornication Matthew 19:9). A single man cannot serve as an elder. He must also NOW have a wife.
- Having faithful children (Titus 1:6) There are some opposing views per this qualification. Let us consider a scriptural look at this qualification. Define faithful: living the Christian life; not what was in the past, "Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life" (Revelation 2:10). The verb "having" is Present tense. It is not the former or future. For your consideration I urge that you study this in depth and ask, "What do the scriptures say about this?" Let us leave this portion of our study with this thought: When we come to a difficult passage, let us take the surest and safest course! Do just what it says! Very seldom is a congregation aware of the courage it takes to be an elder. Let us consider a few final thoughts. An elder is a person who is subject to error in judgment yet must still go ahead with courage and make hard decisions. An elder is a person wanting the approval of those they lead, yet the courage to make decisions based upon spiritual judgment, even if it costs them the favor of the church. An elder is a family man who is aware of the frailty of their own family yet must proceed in leadership knowing that their family will be by association, fall heir to some criticism aimed at them. An elder is a person who is conscious of the weight of his responsibility, yet courageous enough to trust others with the work knowing they may falter, quit or ignore their task. An elder is a person who is in awe of the power of God, knowing one day they will stand in God's presence and answer for their work. It is likely no one on earth would accept such a huge undertaking if they did not know that God was with them through His Word.
