The Answer for the 21st Century

The glorious fact of the gospel of Jesus Christ is that He is Savior. *"God dcommends his love toward us, in that, while we were yet inners Christ died for us"* (Romans 5:8, KJV) Which one of us does not need Him as a Savior? Who is completely pure? What characterizes our daily living -Careless worldly thoughts, self-centered words and actions, failing to do what we know is right? How often do we fail our best expectation of ourselves and especially the higher standard of God's desires for us?

Yet most people are too unconcerned. Actions show it. Even when a knowledge of God is present, we often do not live under God. Most Americans are in some way affiliated with a religious group: yet where will Americans be this Sunday morning, for Sunday evening worship gatherings, for Bible study sessions?

Most people intend someday to do what they think is right? Does that alone show how concerned we are? The Biblical standard presents Christians as concerned with living constantly in the light of God's word and Jesus' life, disciples who act immediately in the spread of the gospel. We of the present age must catch the determination and drive needed so that we may help those who grope for light to see, understand, and accept God and His word as the basis of life, and even to order our own lives better.

The world is filled with problems for which God has provided solutions, from marriage problems to child rearing difficulties, to interpersonal relationships and even to the scourge of war among nations.

Why would we not seek God's answers to our real questions and to life's purpose and practice?

We need to begin anew or continue a study of scripture. Isn't daily consideration of God's word is more importance that any computer game, any football game, any diversion that requires so much that it diverts all attention away from God. To take time, even a few minutes, for higher, better things is a good choice, maybe redeeming the time better than we seem to have been doing.

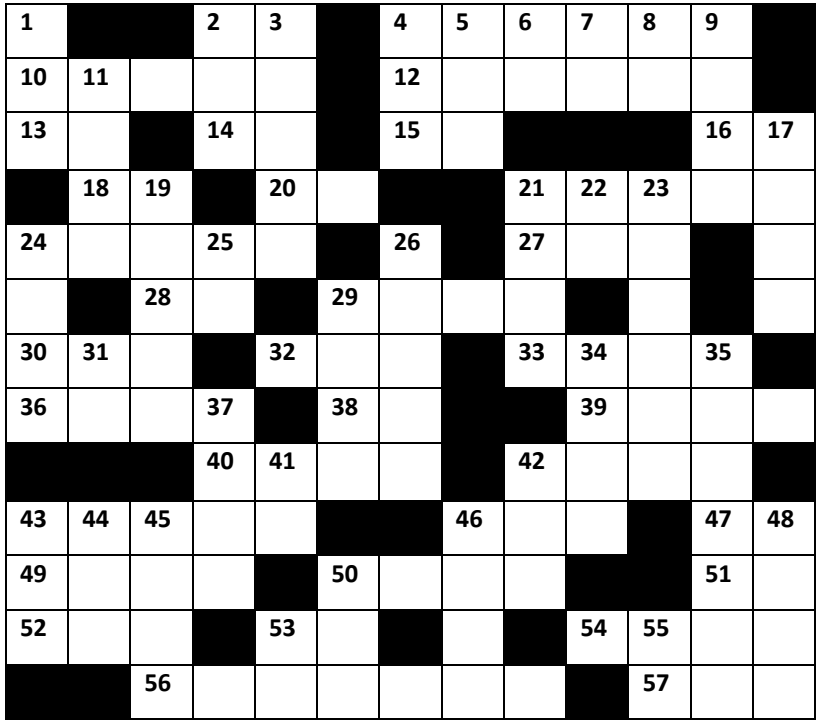

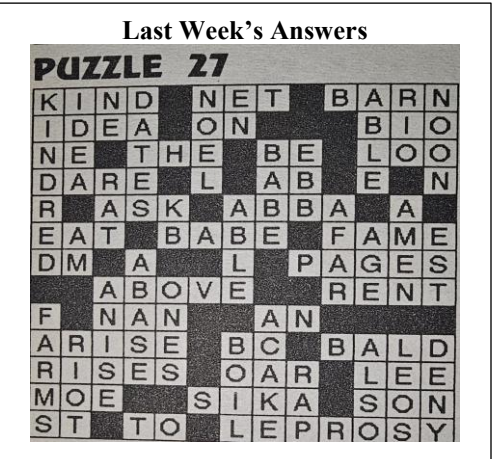
