**He knew, He knew, He knew**

We have recorded three separate instances in the life of Jesus when He predicted specific details about His impending death. Slowly read these. Consider that He knew all of this ahead of time, and yet He still came, He stayed and He endured it all...for you...and me.

Jesus Himself said, “The Son of Man must **suffer** many things, and be **rejected** by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be **killed**, and be **raised** the third day” ([Luke 9:22](#)). Not long after that, He again started telling His disciples, “The Son of Man is being **betrayed** into the hands of men, and they will **kill** Him. And after He is **killed**, He will **rise** the third day” ([Mark 9:31](#)). Less than a year later, it is recorded that He was teaching again, “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and **all** things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be accomplished. For He will be **delivered** to the Gentiles and will be **mocked** and **insulted** and **spit** upon. They will **scourge** Him and **kill** [**crucify**, [Matt. 20:19](#)] Him. And the third day He will **rise** again” ([Luke 18:31-33](#)).
