The Qualifications of an Elder

Continued from last week

Text: I Timothy 3; Titus 1; I Peter 5:1-4

Experience

- **Holy** (Titus 1:8) - This means they are devoted to God and pure in living! This is expected of all Christians.
- **Lover of good men** (Titus 1:8) - An elder should have good deeds, good things and be surrounded by good people. He cannot develop good qualities in others if he has no real love for such things.
- **Given to Hospitality** (I Timothy 3:2) - This is one who is willing to share with others.
- **Vigilant** (I Timothy 3:2) - He is to be wide-awake.

Leadership

- **To Exhort & Convince** (Titus 1:9) - He must be able to lead people to the Lord, "Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints" (Jude 3; emp. added).

Apt to Teach

- Apt to teach (I Timothy 3:2) - This means he is qualified, ready, and prepared, "And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth" (II Timothy 2:24-25).
- **Holding fast the Word** (Titus 1:9) - He must LIVE the Word, "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood" (Acts 20:28; emp. added).

Reputation

- Must have a good report of them which are without (I Timothy 3:7) - He is to be a man that is well thought of by the congregation and community. Even the children of elders must have a good reputation, "If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly" (Titus 1:6). These children could hinder his effectiveness in the congregation and community if their reputation was stained.
