

"Life" Is The Message

Resurrection is no secret: "the king knows of these things ...
this has not been done in a corner" (Acts 26:26, ASV). Herod,
king of the Jews, was expert in Jewish law, customs, and
activities. Paul confidently affirmed that Herod knew of the
resurrection. Herod was faced with the public, powerful,
transforming message of resurrection. Both Jewish and Roman
officials had known: Jewish guards stood before Jesus' tomb
on resurrection morning, and it became common knowledge in
Jerusalem that these men were witnesses of the resurrection.

Witnesses had proclaimed the resurrection, "with great power the apostles gave their witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus" (Acts 4:33, ASV). Paul's message of resurrection demanded something of Herod. He knew the facts and should obey and yield to Jesus as the Messiah and to the gospel message of salvation.

Jesus is raised. Resurrection gives life to Jesus' message and shows that forgiveness is real. Christian life is lived by the power of resurrection. It is the number one issue of life, the very center of everyday living, the power to live with purpose and fulfillment. That is its challenge. Have you faced the issue? Fred Willmon
