Inspiration of the Bible

What makes the Bible different from all other books in the world? The Bible is the Inspired Word of God. The reason that the Bible is unlike any other book in the world has to do with the fact that it and it alone is inspired by God. When we say that the Bible is “inspired,” what do we mean? The English word “inspire” comes from the Latin inspire, which means “to breathe into.” The Bible is the inspired Word of God in that He “breathed into” the writers of the Bible the message He wanted them to produce. The Bible says it is God breathed, “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works” (II Timothy 3:16-17). The Bible is free from all error in its original form. The writers of Scripture, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, did not make factual, historical, scientific, or other kinds of errors (II Peter 1:20-21). While it is true that the Bible does not claim to be a textbook of history, science, or mathematics, whenever the writers of Scripture dealt with matters in these areas, they did not make mistakes; rather, they always wrote what was true. But it does no good to claim that the Bible is inspired unless we can offer adequate proof for its inspiration. Evidence to prove the Bible’s claims of inspiration comes from two main sources. External evidence for inspiration includes such things as historical documentation of biblical people, places, and events, or archaeological artifacts that support the biblical documents. Internal evidence is found within the actual text of the Bible itself. This includes statements in the Bible which show that the actual existence of the Scriptures cannot be explained in any other way except to acknowledge that they are the result of a guiding Mind. The Bible claims to be the inspired Word of God. Therefore, it is accurate.

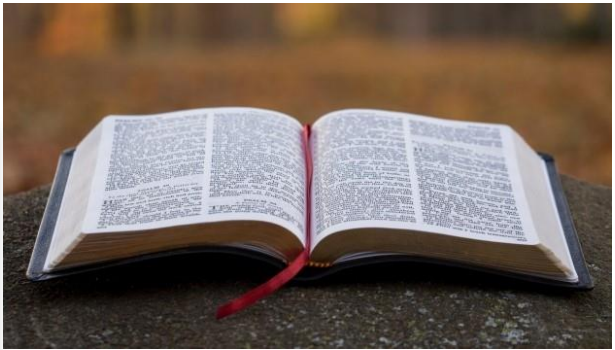
