

INVITING



"Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30).

The Lord Jesus came "to seek and to save that which was lost" (Luke 19:10). The first word Jesus ever preached was "Repent!" (Matthew 4:17). Every sermon and every act revealed His love for people and His great desire for them to leave worldliness and come to righteousness and truth. He ate at the homes of sinners and Pharisees because He hoped to reach everyone.

After convicting the people at Pentecost for crucifying the Lord and Christ (Acts 2:36), Peter urged the people in the first gospel sermon to repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of their sins (2:38). He didn't stop there! And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!" (2:40). We would all do well to invite others to repent, to be baptized, so that they might be saved.

While 3,000 responded and were baptized that day, many others responded later (Acts 4:4; 5:14; 6:1, 7). Some obey the Lord quickly and others come after much thought. If we do not show the need and invite people to respond, they may not see the need to obey.

This is why it is important to invite people to obey the gospel. We are in the business of persuading people to obey the gospel. The cross touches the heart with love, and the resurrection of Jesus provides reasons to believe. Faith and love will move the will to act. Invite others to church, invite them to gospel meetings, and invite them to Bible classes. Teach them the way of the Lord.
