On Being a Helper

Helpers don’t get a lot of recognition in our society, and understandably so. Their jobs are by nature to be in the background. The head coaches, the CEOs, the presidents, the guys and gals in upper management, they are usually the ones who get the press, they are the ones who stand on the podiums and get their pictures made. But we know all too well that without their support staff they could not be where they are.

For example, a typical NFL team may have 10-15 coaches and assistant coaches, but their support staff may involve as many as 2000-3000 people working within the organization. That’s a lot of unnamed and unknown helpers! Yet, these kinds of helpers working behind the scenes are essential for any organization to function at its peak. That includes churches and families.

From the beginning of time God knew that helpers were vitally important. At the culmination of His creative work, as God was about to create Eve, He said, “It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him” (Genesis 2.18). Eve was created to compliment and complete Adam to the point that the two should become one flesh (Genesis 2.24). In fact, both the husband and the wife are helpers for each other. Neither alone fulfill God’s plan for marriage and the family.

God designed the roles in marriage and family so that each family member could enjoy the optimum blessings. When we understand how these roles work beautifully together, we can bypass many of life’s difficulties. Instead of becoming irritated at our differences due to self-centeredness, embracing these differences will help us live a more fulfilled and satisfying life together. Being a “helper” is a high calling, whether our culture recognizes it or not. It’s God’s idea. And His plans are always for our good. Don’t allow the world to convince you that God’s ways are archaic and outdated.” (Mark 10.42-45 – emphasis mine).
