Guideposts For A Godly Life - Proverbs 4:23-27

Although it is a time for graduation celebrations, the principles for living a godly life are great reminders for everyone who follows the Lord. The entire book of Proverbs is a guidebook of principles for wise living. Here are five guideposts from Proverbs 4.

Guard Your Heart. “Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.” The heart is our mind and thoughts, so be careful of what you allow into your mind and how you think about it. That is what ultimately determines who we are and how we respond to the blessings and troubles of life.

Guard your Lips. “Avoid all perverse talk; stay away from corrupt speech.” What we say impacts not only ourselves, but everyone around us. We can bring compassion, love, and support or we can tear down and destroy others. Never let the world decide how we talk to one another.

Guard your Eyes. “Look straight ahead, and fix your eyes on what lies before you.” Watch where you’re going in life by keeping your eyes on the Lord, His Word, and His Ways! There are many distractions in this world, but paying attention to the right things will help you stay on the right path!

Guard your Steps. “Mark out a straight path for your feet; stay on the safe path.” Pay attention to the habits you develop in your life. Cultivate a way of life that leads to health, well-being, and that honors God.

Guard Your Direction. “Don’t get sidetracked; keep your feet from following evil.” The faith journey is often a varied one. We are strong, then weak, then strong again. It is important to keep moving in the right direction - toward eternal life. As my friend David Watson says often, if you miss heaven, you’ve missed it all. Read through the book of Proverbs once a month - one chapter per day - for excellent guideposts for living the wise life!
