"Charge them that are rich in this present world; that they be not high-minded, nor have their hope set on certain riches, but on God; who gives us richly all things to enjoy, that they be ready to distribute, willing to communicate; laying up for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may have LAY HOLD ON THE LIFE WHICH IS LIFE INDEED" (1 Timothy 6:17-19)
