Restoration

"Therefore, take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock.

Also, from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves. Therefore, watch and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears. So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified." Acts 20:28-32

These words of admonition given by the Apostle Paul to the Elders of the church at Ephesus are needed in every generation. We have often heard it said that "apostasy" is only a generation away. This means that each new generation must be grounded in the Word of God. Paul commended these Elders to the Word of God as a means of remaining faithful and avoiding perverse doctrines.

In his book, *Campbell and Controversy*, Bill J. Humble mentions several of the restoration movements that were occurring among churches in America in the 1800's. Thomas Campbell, and his son Alexander Campbell, departed from the Presbyterian Church desiring to leave human creeds and institutions and unite everyone on the principles and tenets of the Bible. James O'Kelly came from the Methodist Church and was seeking to do the same thing the Campbells were, even though they did not know initially about each other's efforts. A similar movement among the Baptists in New England was being led by Elias Smith and Abner Jones, and they were simply calling themselves "Christians." All these men were working independently for some time without knowledge of each other.

Bill Humble affirms that it was God who was working in the hearts of these men, and the movements should be attributed to God and not the human agencies he used to achieve the restoration. Humble writes:

It was inconceivable that these independent streams of thought could all honor the New Testament as the sole authority in their quest for ancient Zion, act consistently upon that principle, and remain permanently separated. Rather the various groups found their principles in ever closer accord, and by 1832 the major streams of Restoration history had merged into one, with Alexander Campbell its universally recognized champion. Many referred to these groups as "Campbellites," but they rejected the name and the idea that they were followers of any man, including Alexander Campbell. They chose to be called Christians. As Thomas Campbell would write, "We are Christians only, but we are not the only Christians."

We are far removed from those times and from those men, but we are still in need of the instruction that Paul gave to the Elders from Ephesus centuries before these men and these movements occurred. The need for restoration is a burden that every generation must carry. We need only investigate the Bible to see why this is true. Read the Book of Judges; read the histories of Israel and Judah. When Elijah confronted the Prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel, he was seeking to restore the people of God to the true worship of Jehovah. He was a restoration preacher. As Paul warned Timothy, "Now the Spirit expressly says that in the latter times some will depart from the faith..." (1 Tim. 4:1). That is why every generation needs Restoration.
