The Great Question

Part 4 It Brings the Greatest Reward to Man – by Clem Thurman

The purpose of God’s plan is stated clearly. “*And Peter said to them, “Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”* (Acts 2:38) “*And now why do you wait? “Rise and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on his name.”* (Acts 22:16) In the great commission given by Jesus to the twelve, the Lord said, “*And he said to them, “Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.”* (Mark 16:15-16). Because all men are sinners, the greatest need of all men is forgiveness. Paul wrote, “*for in Christ Jesus, “you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”* (Gal. 3:26-27). Because we are “*in Christ*” we are promised redemption, forgiveness, and every spiritual blessing.” (Eph. 1:3, 7).


The Lord Jesus promised, “*And behold I am with you always to the end of age.*” (Matt. 28:20). Surely, we don’t deserve it, but what a reward it is to have Jesus through all of the trials of life! When you are troubled, “*He cares for you*”. (1 Peter 5:7). He promises “*“ I will never leave you nor forsake you.”* (Heb. 13:5). The apostle Paul often wrote of the help of the Lord in his life. “*I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service, though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent.* (1 Tim. 11:12) “*for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.*” (Phil. 2:13) “*I can do all things through him who strengthens me.*” (Phil. 4:13). Trials come to all of us, with temptations and various problems. But Jesus has promised to be with us and help us. “*Finally, be strong in the Lord in the strength of his might.*”

Our proper response to God’s answer to the great question, “*Lord, what shall I do?*” brings us from lost to saved, from despair to hope, from doubt to assurance. Jesus told the disciples, “*In my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that were I am you may be also.*” When we are “*buried with Christ in baptism,*” we are also raised with him through faith in the working of God”. (Rom. 6:3-4; Col. 2:12). Being “*Risen with Christ*” (Col. 3:1), we have assurance of life beyond the grave. “*For we know that if the tent which is our earthly home, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made by hands, eternal in the heavens.*” (2 Cor. 5:1). Eternal life is “*in Christ*” 1 John 5:1), and because we have been *buried into Christ*” (Rom. 6:3; Gal. 3:27), we are assured: “*I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life.*” (1 John 5:13).

Asking the right question matters and listening for the right answer matters as well. Asking “*What shall I do*” shows we need God’s help through Jesus Christ. He is your friend. How will you answer?
