## God's Involvement

The last part of Isaiah's message from the Lord involves God's active part in the affairs of men, especially His chosen people. He tells Isaiah to go to a mountain top and witness the Lord come with power. But His coming to His own people will not be with retribution, but as a shepherd, tenderly guiding His sheep. In fact, He will gather up the weak (the lambs) and will take them in His arms to keep them safe. What imagery could God use that would make us feel more secure?! God is not coming with a belt and a whipping. He is coming as a loving Father whose only desire is the well-being of His people. God's presence should not frighten us. It should calm and reassure us.

Repeatedly we are reminded of this great attribute of the Lord. He cares about us just as a loving parent care for his or her child. Our response is described by the apostle peter when he says, *"Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you"* (1 Peter 5:6-7). When Jesus taught about this (Matt. 6), He explained that God feeds the birds, and he makes the flowers beautiful as they bloom. Yet, Jesus assures us we are worth much more than the creation. God is with us! *"What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us"* (Rom. 8:31). What encouragement can we take from Isaiah 40?

## God's Promises are Found in Christ

The language of Isaiah 40:3 is used to describe the coming of the Son of God (Matt. 3:3). The coming of Jesus was the arrival of the long-awaited Son of God. He was not just another prophet, but the Messiah. *"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God.... And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth"* (John 1:1-2, 14). We can take comfort knowing that God has kept His promise. He sent a Savior who lived a perfect life and could then be a perfect sacrifice for our sins.

We shouldn't become so downhearted. We are not alone to face this world and its trials. Jesus came to assure us that He is with us and will not abandon us. On the night just before His crucifixion, Jesus assured the apostles (and us) with these words: *"Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, and where I am, there you may be also"* (John 14:1-3). Jesus will not keep Satan's attacks from impacting us. But He will sustain us because He keeps His promises. And one of those promises is that Jesus will never fail us.
