

Hold On!!!

I have been thinking about my grandmother lately. She was 94 when she passed. She saw a lot of water flow under the bridge during her lifetime. When she was a little girl she went everywhere in a wagon but lived to see men and women travel into space and return. She lived through the depression, World War II, the Korean Conflict, Vietnam, Desert Storm, Enduring Freedom and the ongoing war on terrorism. She saw America ride a roller coaster in politics, foreign policy, economics, trade, and patriotism. She saw so much of both the good and the bad. However, she held on to her faith through all those years. She did not give up on her country or her God. She knew that one day she would see him face to face and O what a glorious day that was. The writer of Hebrews said, "You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised" (Hebrews 10:36). And in 12:1 he said, "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us." James said, "Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him" (James 1:12).

It is important to God and therefore important to all of us, to not "grow weary in well doing" (Galatians 6:9). We can't give up on our country or on God. We must persevere. God has a work for each of us to do if we just do not give up too soon. The very blessing we long for may be within our reach around the next corner or just over the next rise in the road. God has a plan for our lives and we must leave room for him to work. The Psalmist was fond of the phrase, "wait upon the Lord." God is at work and we have to continue to trust Him no matter how difficult times may be. Our faith in Him cannot waiver. He is the one who can make a difference in our country, our government, our homes, our marriage, our children, our schools, and every other area of our lives. We must persevere.

Winston Churchill gave a speech to parliament on June 4, 1940 and in that speech he made this famous statement concerning the will of the British people: ...we shall not flag or fail. We shall go on to the end. We shall fight in France, we shall fight on the seas and oceans, we shall fight with growing confidence and growing strength in the air, we shall defend our island, whatever the cost may be. We shall fight on the beaches, we shall fight on the landing grounds, we shall fight in the fields and in the streets, we shall fight in the hills; we shall never surrender, and if, which I do not for a moment believe, this island or a large part of it were subjugated and starving, then our Empire beyond the seas, armed and guarded by the British Fleet, would carry on the struggle, until, in God's good time, the New World, with all its power and might, steps forth to the rescue and the liberation of the old.
