God's Presence Is Felt in Jesus

The idea of God coming to the city of Jerusalem would be both concerning and comforting. It would have concerned the people because they knew they had failed to keep the Law of Moses. It would have comforted them to know the Lord would forgive, accepting them in spite of their sin. The Lord would dwell with His people.

This prophecy was literally fulfilled in the life and ministry of Jesus. As we have seen, John tells us when we see and know Jesus, we have seen and can know the Father. When we wonder, "what would God do in this situation?", we find our answer in the actions and attitudes we see in Jesus. That is why Peter tells us, *"For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps"* (1 Peter 2:21).

The Lord doesn't just want us to know of His promises, He wants us to "feel" them. That is, He wants us, like a toddler in the lap of his or her mother, to know that we are safe in the arms of Jesus. We have nothing to fear. This is the message God has for us today. We can feel safe in the Lord's presence, salvation, and love. *"The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What will man do to me?"* (Heb. 13:6).

God's Purposes are Finished In Reality

When God makes a promise, it is not just a promise of some future ideal existence. It is a promise that holds out hope for us today. Sometimes, we think that the only promises God has for us are those found in His presence in heaven. However, God is concerned for us here today. He is active in this world to reassure us of His love and His protection. That is why the Lord Jesus said, *"For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, as to what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, as to what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth much more than they?"* (Matt. 6:25-26). Our clothes and daily food are the most basics of human needs. Jesus reassures us that God knows this. And, if God can feed the birds, He can certainly take care of His children, made in His image!

Isaiah is prophesying of a time when Israel will be restored, and all things will be put right. It didn't happen suddenly. It took time. But, when the time was right, God kept every promise He made then, and God will keep every promise He has made to us. It may take time (and, as is often the case, we may be in a hurry while God moves at a pace that is best for us). But God will keep his promises. That is the message of Isaiah.


