Some time ago I read an AP news article reporting that our federal government created a commission to "find a way to make up the growing revenue shortfall in the program that funds highway repairs and construction." It seems that motorists are not buying enough gasoline/diesel to generate the funds to keep our transportation infrastructure moving forward.

Wait just a second... let me get this straight. We have been being beat up because we are such fuel gluttons for **how long**? We have been told that we are the primary offenders causing holes in the ozone, the greenhouse effect, global warming and only the Lord knows what else. All because we use too much fossil fuel! The world is full of people who have the answer (most of which is no answer at all!). Unfortunately, some of these people make it to positions of authority and are taken seriously. Some of them are well-meaning and some are self-serving. Some are smart and some are idiots, and some are both. But they don't row my boat! The Lord does. Like the Father thundered at Peter on the Mount of Transfiguration [speaking of Jesus], "THIS is my son, whom I love. Listen to HIM." This is just more incentive to read your Bible regularly and follow what it says. "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away." Jesus.
