## "Learning To Walk"

Along with jogging, walking has become a popular exercise and outdoor sport. I often see individuals and entire families enjoying a walk in the park or in the forest preserves. When driving on the highway, I sometimes wave to "walking parties" heading for some distant rendezvous.

The Christian life can be compared to a walk. In fact, this is one of Paul's favorite pictures: Walk in a manner worthy of your calling" (Eph. 4:1); "you must no longer walk as the gentiles do" (Eph. 4:17); "walk in love" (Eph. 5:2); "walk as children of light" (Eph. 5:8).

The Christian life begins with a step of faith. But that step leads to a walk of faith, "For we walk by faith, not by sight" (2 Cor. 5:7). Walking suggests progress, and we must make progress in the Christian life (Phil. 3:13–16; Heb. 6:1). Walking also demands strength, and God has promised, "As your days, so shall your strength be" (Deut. 33:25).

But we must be sure to "walk in the light" for the enemy has put traps and detours to catch us (1 John 1:5–7). Of course, at the end of life's walk, we will step into the very presence of the Lord. "And Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him" (Gen. 5:24).
