# Zion's News & Notes

#### A Few Words From Pastor Janet

Elizabeth, my 13-year old, had been counting down the days, not just until the end of the school year, but for the day she would return to Lake Chautauqua Lutheran Center for her third year of a week of Classic Camp. She is there now.

I was introduced to LCLC almost immediately upon arriving in the Upstate NY Synod, as my congregation planned a retreat there, and just as quickly learned it was a beloved place. Every year when it came time for confirmation camp, there would be a kid or two who really didn't want to go, some of whom had never been away from family before. By the end of the camp week, these same kids were hugging their cabinmates and counselors, exchanging phone numbers and, some, even crying at leaving their new friends and the shared experience behind. Even the most reluctant grudgingly admitted, "Yeah, it wasn't as bad as I thought it would be".

Thank God for Lake Chautauqua Lutheran Center and its ministry with youth! One year, the Sunday after my daughter Julianna returned from a week at camp, only 8 years old but already a third year veteran, during the sharing of the Peace she told me she wanted to say something to everyone but she wanted me with her. That's always a bit risky, isn't it? Not that I haven't been embarrassed before during the children's message. But she came up the center aisle and, at the end of the announcements, gave a testimony about how God is real and in her life. I remember how proud I was of her, that she had the courage to get up in front of the congregation and share her faith. Now I just feel gratitude that she had those experiences and Christians in her life to help build that foundation of faith.

When Lee Miller was bishop (our current bishop's father), he was known for asking pastoral candidates who Jesus was for them. Lee Lindemann, who served as Executive Director of LCLC for 17 years, asked that same question of those who applied to be counselors of the summer youth program. He wanted counselors who were qualified and skilled in more than just swimming or singing, but also comfortable talking about Jesus and their faith in a genuine way.

The majority of young pastors in the ELCA credit their campus ministry and church camp experiences for their faith formation and hearing the call to serve. Ministries like LCLC not only help nurture future pastors but also the congregational leaders who serve on council and committees and lead service projects in their community.

LCLC is part of Lutheran Outdoor Ministry and is supported by the mission dollars we send to the Upstate New York Synod.

ing at John 3:17, "Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the


world but in order that the world might be saved through him", this session explores
