Zion's News & Notes

A Few Words From Pastor Bill

SUDDENLY everything changes! On the Sunday of Transfiguration we found ourselves on a mountaintop and with the disciples witness the dazzling brilliance of Jesus, and hear the Lord's words: "This is my son...listen to him". On Ash Wednesday we hear words that could seem hard on our ears: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return". Marked with a dark cross of ash on our foreheads there is evidence of our humanness.

And yet, just as ash reminds us that we are human, the mark is that of the lifegiving cross. This same cross was marked on our foreheads at baptism. Think about this as we journey through the time of Lent, a journey of forty days, when we again pray and long for a deeper understanding of what it means to be a child of God...we have already been reconciled to God through Christ.

Now the fact that we are reconciled to God does not lessen the need for and the importance for these days of Lent. Traditionally this is a time to search our hearts as we journey with Jesus toward the cross. It is a time for each of us to consider what it means, today, to be God's child in the midst of God's creation.

From my Lenten file: The Lenten Prayer of St. Ephrem the Syrian -

O Lord and Master of my life! Take from me the spirit of sloth, faint-heartedness, lust of power, and idle talk. But give rather the spirit of chastity, humility, patience, and love to Thy servant. Yes, O Lord and King! Grant me to see my own errors and not to judge my brother; For Thou are blessed unto ages of ages. Amen.

Everything changes! We begin this time of Lent together. I do not know what changes may come our way. While I anticipated stepping back as Transition Pastor at the end of February, as I compose this message a new Interim/ Transition Pastor has not been identified. As we enter March I will modify my level of involvement, but continue to journey with Zion. I will likely continue to preside at Worship twice a month with Deacon Patsy Glista presiding once a month. While things are changing, be assured that Bishop Miller, Synod Staff, and Dean Ferguson continue to search for a Transition Pastor to work with Zion...but, until that day, we will continue to journey together.
