

# ***CAMP RULES***

We encourage **ALL** campers to abide by these rules and be good examples to our youth!

## **Section I: Rules on Appearance:**

- A. Christian appearance at **ALL** times
- B. Modest apparel at **ALL** times
- C. Skirts must below the knees.
- D. No sleeveless or see through apparel of **ANY** kind.
- E. No makeup including French tip nails.
- F. Sportswear must abide by the same guidelines as all other clothing. In addition, no culottes; slacks or shorts for girls. No shorts or revealing sweatpants for boys. Athletic pants are **FOR SPORTS ONLY!**

## **Section II: Rules on Manner**

- A. No physical contact between singles.
- B. Observe good manners at **ALL** times.
- C. No running allowed except in sports related to recreation.
- D. All campers are to attend all services unless excused.
- E. Everyone is to remain in church until dismissed.
- F. No worldly music!
- G. No worldly media (i.e. TV; YouTube; Netflix, etc)
- H. Girls are forbidden in boy's quarters. Boys are forbidden in girl's quarters.
- I. To be in camp ensemble, camper must be at least seeking the Holy Ghost and living a holy life.
- J. Campers violating rules will be dismissed from the campgrounds.

## **Section III: Rules Governing Physical Property**

- A. The camp management assumes no responsibility for anything lost or stolen.
- B. Trailing parking and/or Living quarters shall not be utilized without permission.
- C. Renters will assume responsibility for any damage done and will pay for the repair of the same. Mattresses are to be protected when used by children. Please **LEAVE** beds and other furnishings arranged as you found them.
- D. No cooking allowed in living quarters except in designated areas by adults.
- E. No pets allowed on grounds.
- F. The mutilation of trees and property is prohibited.
- G. The discharge of firearms and/or fireworks is prohibited.
- H. All living quarters are expected to be kept clean. Including common areas within each building. The renters of living quarters left unclean will receive a bill for clean-up.
