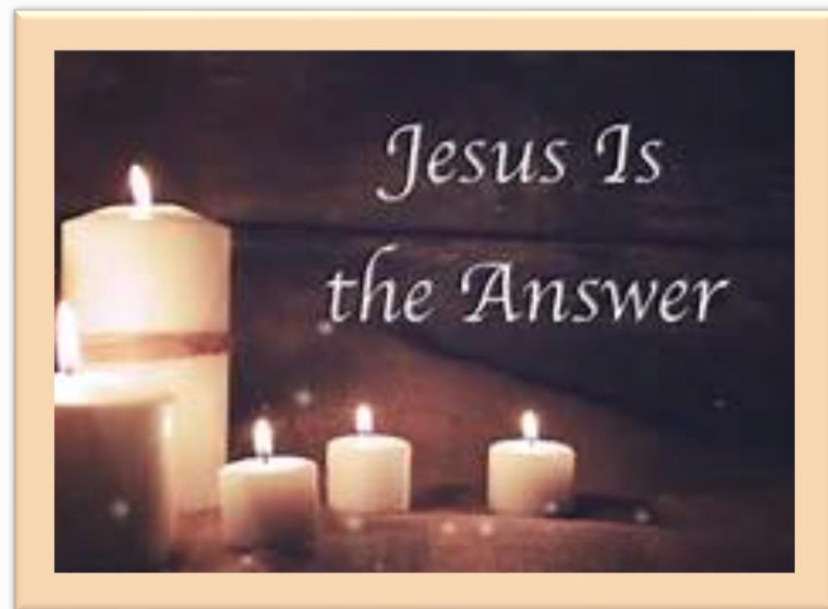

The LORD is my Banner.**

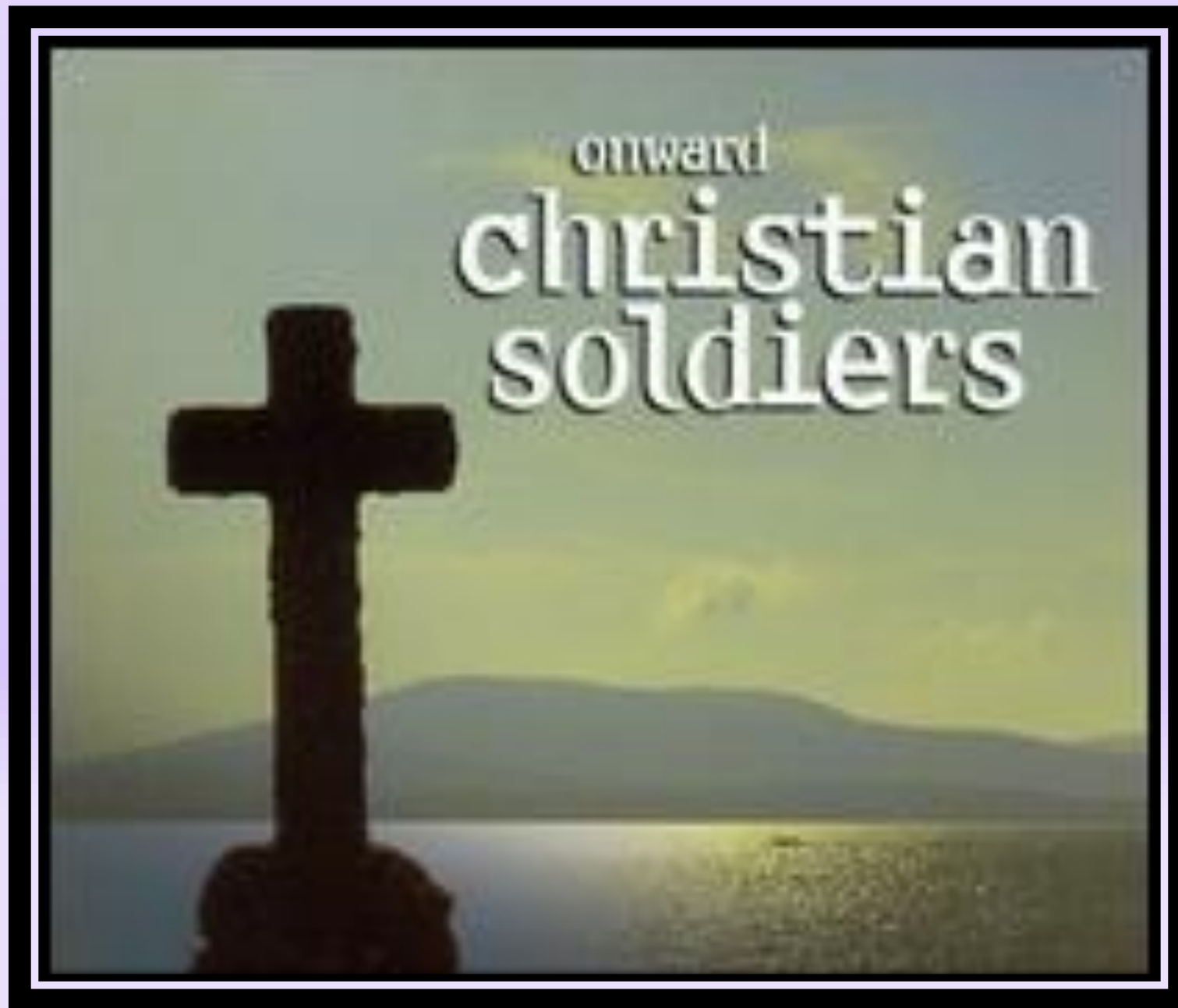
