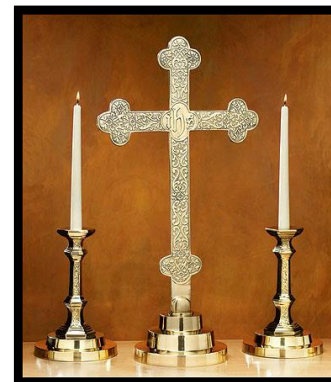

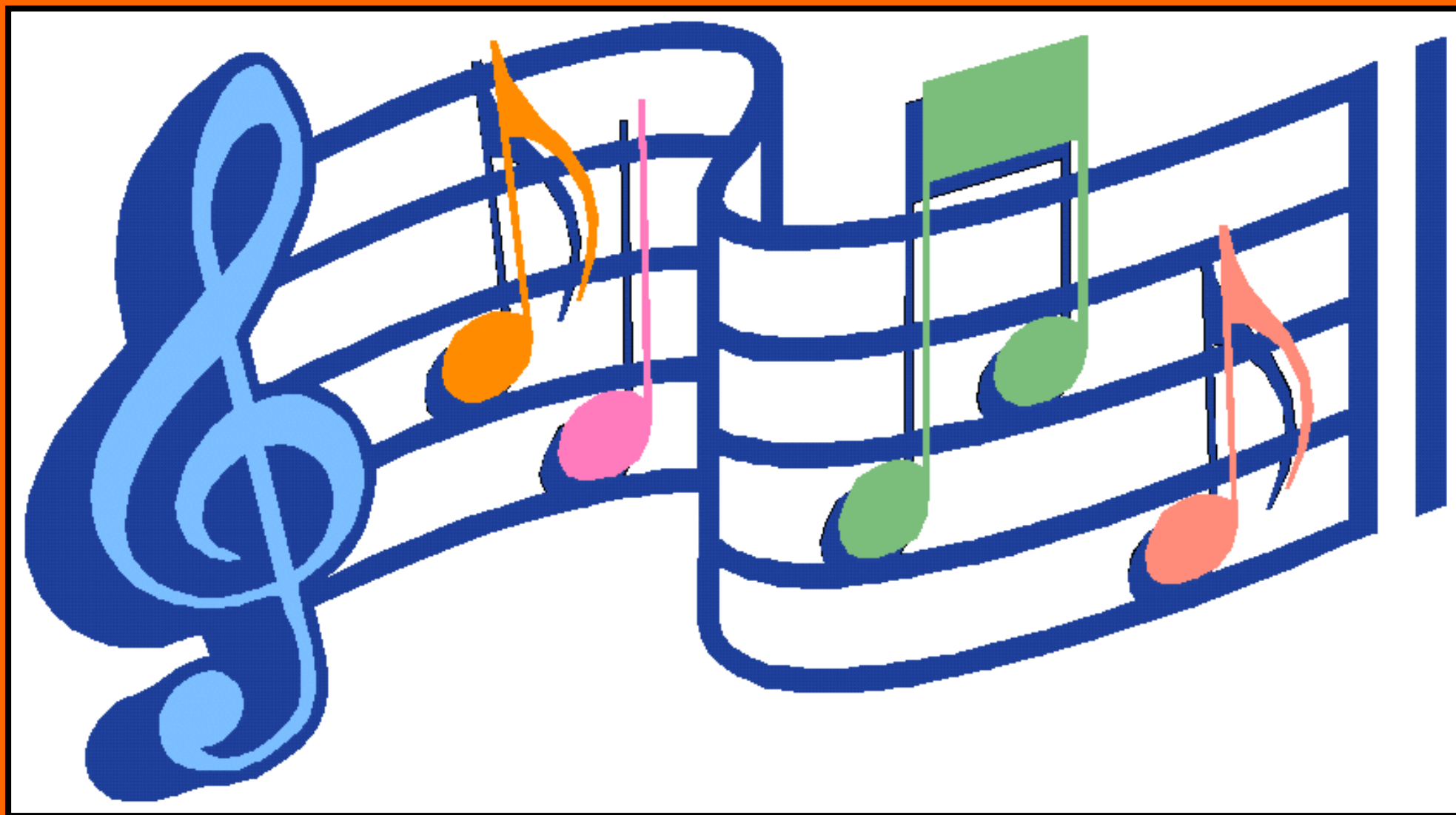

## The Greatest Commandment

<sup>34</sup> Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. <sup>35</sup> One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: <sup>36</sup> “Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?”

<sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: “‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’<sup>[b]</sup> <sup>40</sup> All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.”

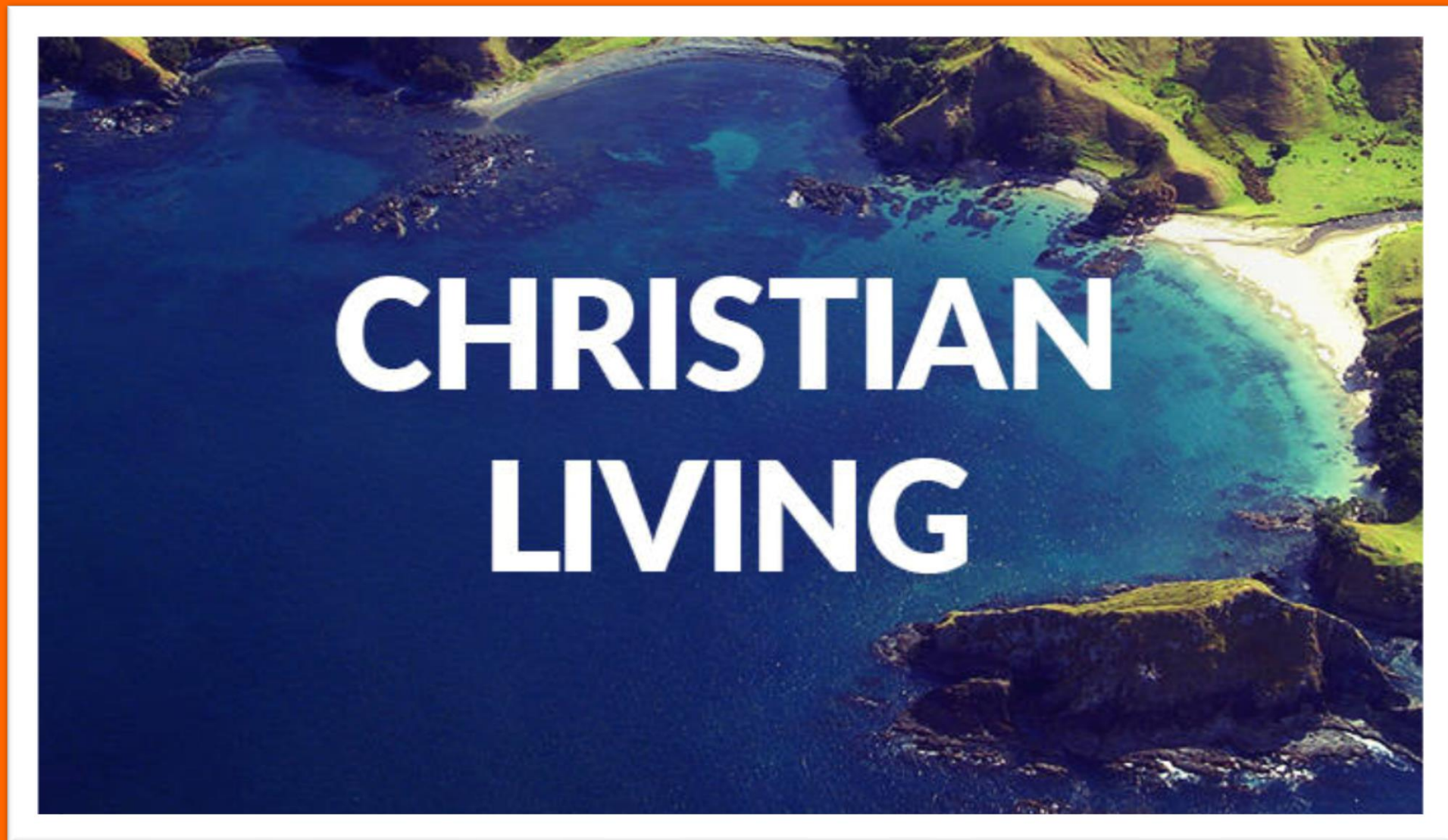

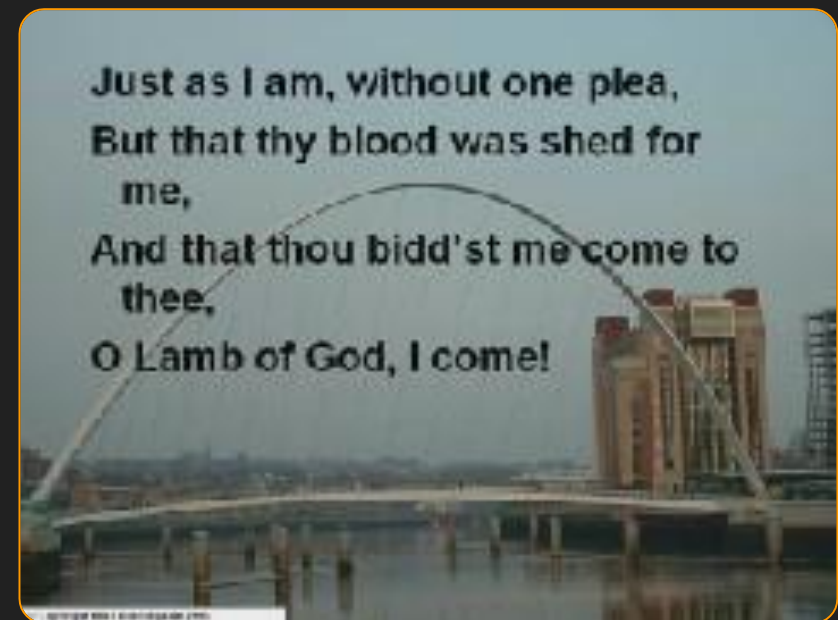

# Preparation for Communion

## People's Community Church Covenant

*(Please read in unison)*

“We, the members of this church, do solemnly covenant together with God, and with one another that we will abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul;

bitterness, anger, wrath, clamor,  
and evil speaking: and we will  
be tenderhearted, forgiving one  
another even as God for Christ's  
sake hath forgiven us.

We who are heads of families will observe the worship of God in our homes and will endeavor to lead our children or others committed to our care, to a saving knowledge and personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. We will attend regularly, so far as Providence permits,

the service of worship on the Lord's Day and such other services as the church may appoint. We will observe together the Lord's Supper.

We will aid as the Lord prospers us, in the support of a faithful Christian ministry among us, and in sending the saving gospel of Christ to the whole human family.

We will remember those who have the rule over us, esteeming them very highly for their work's sake. For them we will faithfully pray, and with them we will faithfully labor, as it may be our privilege. God being our helper, this we do covenant to do".

Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD." And you forgave the guilt of my sin.

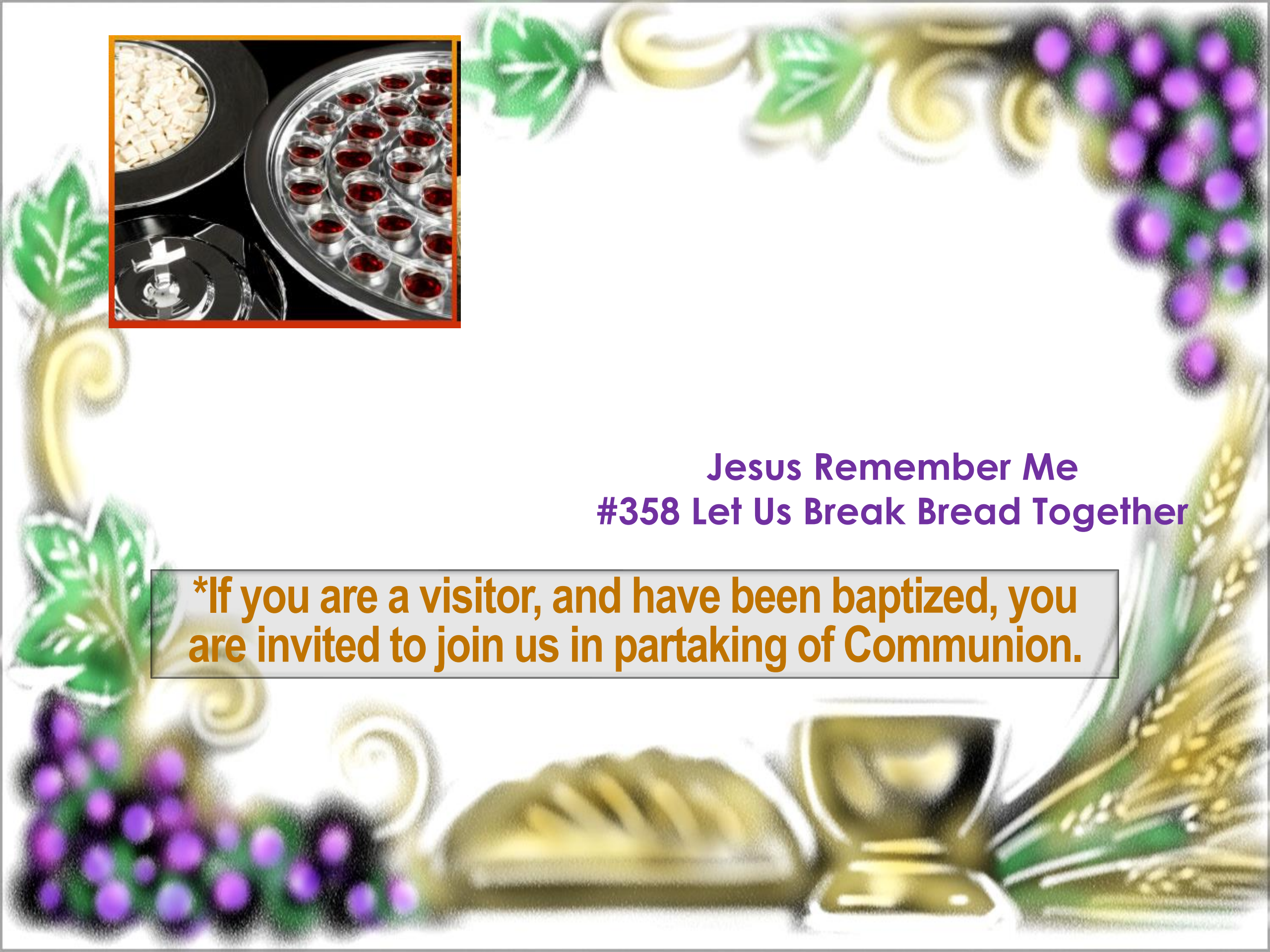
