Stay calm in today's political environment

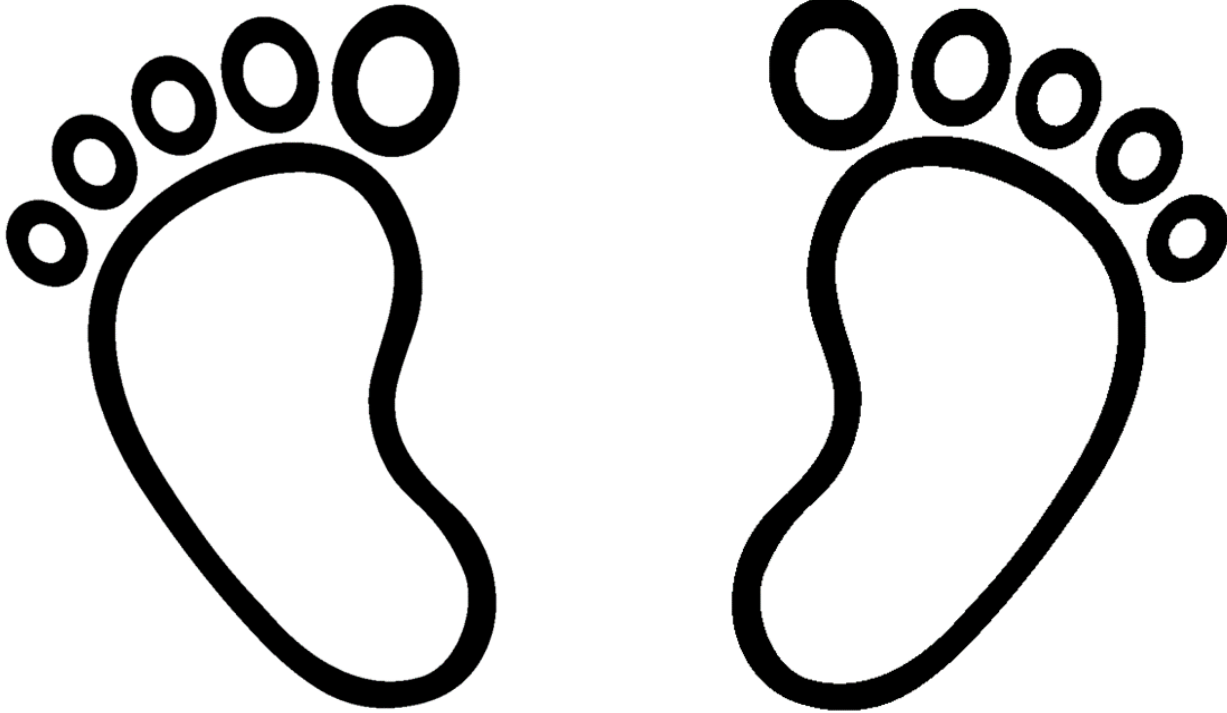
Help others move forward
