Last week I noticed that a friend of my who serves a church in Iowa posted a question on Facebook: "How would you complete the following sentence? I dream of a church


Some of the responses:

Board Update:

The Board of Directors met on Sunday, Sept. 12 and reviewed the year-to-date report of current finances. Due to lower than expected gifts and tithes for the year, the Board approved sending a letter to the congregation seeking increased giving to cover operational expenses for the remainder of the year. The Trustees' Quarterly Report August 30, 2021 showed a net gain of \$XXXXX for the year. Total funds held by the Trustees were \$XXXX. October is traditionally a time to begin thinking of our harvest. Fall harvest is the busiest time of the year for many farmers in our region. They're harvesting corn, planting winter wheat, and planning crops and seed purchases for the spring. Local farmers markets are brimming with harvests of late season fruits and vegetables.

Fall is also a very busy time for Unity Christian Church. Much like the farmer, we're taking assessment of the seeds that have been planted. So many seeds have been planted for training leaders, programing, and spiritual growth for all ages. Investment of seeds planted in 2019 for media equipment and training have provided for regular delivery of sermons and outreach by streaming on Facebook Live YouTube. It's now a part of how we worship. We're so thankful for this opportunity and the dedication of members of the Media Team. In September our music ministry staff was recognized for over 75 years of combined service. The music program recently received a special gift to purchase a sound system to further enhance the music and streaming broadcasts. Investments have been made into the physical building and infrastructure. The most recent are the heating and cooling systems.

Members are the foundation to the seed sowing at Unity and continuing God's work. Everyone is being asked to assess individual priorities for sowing seeds of faith and growing the vision of Unity Christian Church. Together we're harvesting a strong and vibrant faith family which will celebrate Unity's Tenth Anniversary on January 2, 2022. Join us in celebration of our harvest and hope for the future.


