Tuesday - Course descriptions

Doctrine of Prayer (CLS 4014): Teach on the fundamental purpose, principles, and power of prayer. Understand prayer as the channel of communication of the believer to the Father. Instructors: Deacon Robert Barnard and Deacon Vera Hamilton. Textbook: Holy Bible

Women in the New Testament (CLS 1114)/Women in the Old Testament (CLS 1066). Engage in an overview of Biblical women in the New and Old Testaments and the contributions women made to the growth and decline of the Jewish nation. Instructor: Rev. Jacquelyn Hill-Henderson. Textbooks: Holy Bible and Life Principles from the Women in the Bible by Wayne Barber.

Introduction to the Bible (CLS 1001) - Youth ages 6-12. An introduction to the books of the Bible, its origin, and the important periods, events and personalities. Instructor: Ms. Kim Kelly. Textbook: Holy Bible and Bible Basics for Kids: An Awesome Adventure Through God's Word.

Effective Bible Reading (CLS 1004): Identify the methods and approaches to Bible study that can lead to spiritual growth and maturity. Instructor: Rev. Patricia Williamson. Textbooks: Holy Bible and How to Read the Bible for All its Worth by Gordon Fee and Douglas Stuart.

Survey of Genesis (CLS 1011): Explore this book of the beginnings to learn the basic themes of the Bible. Discussions will include such theses as original sin, God's initial steps to redemption through the divine covenant, and the beginning of the covenant people, Israel: Textbooks: Holy Bible and You Can Understand the Book of Genesis, Skip Heitzig.

How to Accurately Interpret the Bible (CLS 1006): Course Instructor: Ms. Vera Hollingsworth. Students will be led to employ the tools of hermeneutics. With these tools, students will engage in biblical analysis during the class period. Textbook: Interpreting the Scriptures by Kevin Conner and Ken Malmin.

Survey of the New Testament (CLS 1072): Engage in a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people and archaeology of the New Testament sections of the Bible.
