The council feels that it is time to reinvent the Evangelism committee with an increased emphasis on technology and modern communication. We have entered into a new era of communication and the church needs to be taking advantage of all the technology available to us to get our word out, not only to prospective members but also to our congregation. With that said, we are looking for volunteers to chair as well as work on this committee.

Our grounds have never looked as well maintained as they do now thanks to Bob Keim, but the council is also still seeking a new Maintenance supervisor to manage the maintenance work. Much of the physical work is now done by contractors due to the age of our congregation but someone still needs to determine what needs to be done. The Council closely monitors the pandemic and hopefully things will get to a point when it will be safe to return to normal Sunday services sometime in the near future.

#### **2020 Call Committee News** Temple Talk by Pat Heimbach November 22, 2020

Good morning, my name is Pat Heimbach. As a member of the call committee, I am responsible for completing all the online forms required by the ELCA for the call process, including the 14-page Ministry Site Profile. There are several sets of instructions that must be followed in a special sequence in order for Gloria Dei's paperwork to reach the ELCA's database. We recently had a technical glitch, but with the help of synod that has been resolved.

The Call Process is basically finding a partnership with a prospective candidate who shares a common purpose in our ministry. The call committee has now completed the required documentation and it has gone through the mandatory reviews. With that said, I am pleased to announce that I have electronically submitted our documents into the ELCA nationwide database. Now prospective candidates can view our profile to determine if they feel they would be a good fit with our congregation.

Each prospective candidate seeking a call in the Florida Bahamas Synod submits what is called a Rostered Leader Profile to the Office of the Bishop. A synod team will now compare Rostered Leader Profiles against our Ministry Site Profile. Carefully and prayerfully, they will select several matches to create a list of candidates for the call committee to interview. They will also give us instruction on the interview process. This is where we are now, waiting for synod to do their portion of the process.

This is definitely not a quick and easy process and that is as it should be, because this is a very important step in the life of our congregation as well as a big commitment to our prospective new pastor.

I hope this gives you some insight into the process of calling a new pastor. If you have any questions regarding the process, please contact anyone on the call committee.

If you would like to read the two documents that the committee has filed with the Synod and the ELCA please go to the church website or call the church office to get a printed copy.

Yes, this is a lengthy process, but it takes time and patience to listen, hear and discern what God wants for our congregation. He is not only speaking to the call committee, but to you as well. Thank you.

The Call Committee is in recess until the Synod Bishop's committee has prayerfully reviewed all of the applicants for consideration for pastor at Gloria Dei. Only those applicants that meet our needs will be put on a list for the Call Committee's review. This is step #6 in a 12-step process.
