Pastor's Message

Grace and peace be yours from God our Father and our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen

This joyful Eastertide, away with sin and sorrow! My love, the Crucified, has sprung to life this morrow. Had Christ, who once was slain, not burst his three-day prison, our faith had been in vain. But now has Christ arisen, arisen, arisen, arisen. *(Evangelical Lutheran Worship Hymn #391)*



- What joy these words bring to my heart! This is one of my favorite Easter hymns, and it seems even more joyous this year because, in ways, it seems like we have just been through an entire year of Lent. Our world has been in a dark place, too many changes have been made in our lives (by necessity), too many loved ones have become ill, and many have died from COVID-19.
- But, as I said in my homily during Drive In Communion on Tuesday, March 23, we are called to see the silver lining in the clouds that come our way. One of those silver linings has been in the new shape of our worship and our congregational life.
- In the past year we have improved our online worship experience. We started out our journey with just a short service with me standing in the pulpit reading the lesson, giving the sermon and offering prayers. It progressed with the addition of readers (Byron Kirkpatrick and Arlene Kelly), an assisting minister (Pat Bressler), music and lyrics led by our Music Director Paul Motto, and after a few months of making software and hardware adjustments and additions, our dynamic duo Irv and Sue Johnson can now record the service, assemble it in a beautiful video, and our online presence has become an experience that we can be proud of. Working behind the scenes to make sure that our sanctuary was adorned with the season-appropriate paraments, candles, palms, lilies, etc. was Crystal Kirkpatrick. And, thanks to Mary Beth Morris, Mary Greer, and, most recently, our new webmaster Paityn Miller, our videos have been uploaded and featured on our website and Facebook page.
- In July 2020 we added our Virtual Coffee Hour which has been enjoyed by our members ever since. Zoom has become our internet platform of choice and has served us well as we come together to share our stories and our concerns on Sunday morning at 11.
- By late September 2020 it became very apparent that Holy Communion was being seriously missed by the congregation. So, with the addition of an FM transmitter and some other electronics we were able to take our worship "to the streets." (Well, maybe just into the parking lot.) The comments about this Holy Communion service have all been positive and it has been a welcome experience that has kept us close to our Lutheran heritage and nourished on our Lord, Jesus Christ's body and blood.
- Keep praying for an end to this pandemic, keep wearing your masks and washing your hands.

Council Corner for April 2021 By William Birdsall, Council president

This has been an exciting month for the Gloria Dei Church Council, as well as our congregation. As you know by now, the Call Committee has identified a prospective pastoral candidate with a lot of help from our Synod representative. At a joint meeting between the Call Committee and Council the call committee recommended this candidate and the council approved. The Council now has certain responsibilities to act in a timely manner to interview the candidate and negotiate compensation. Our interview (via Zoom) is scheduled for the first week in April and then, if all goes as planned, arrangements will be made for the congregation to meet the candidate in person. We expect that this will take place in April, hopefully the second or third week. The council is praying on this every day, so please join us and keep up all those good prayers!

The Council has been conducting business as usual, having our monthly meetings, solving problems and taking actions where necessary. Four significant actions were taken this month including replacing the hose bibbs on the outside of the building, installation of air purifying equipment in all the HVAC systems, inspection of the entire roof system on the Church and replacement of the downstairs water heater. The water heater was 36 years old and in bad shape. We also conducted a review of our insurance policy with our insurance company representative to assure that we had proper coverage.

We still have a vacancy on the Church Council and are badly in need of a volunteer to fill that position. With a new Pastor coming on board very soon we would like to start out with a full council. We know there will be a lot of work to do, and we need all the help we can get. This Council has been operating very smoothly and serving can be a very rewarding experience. So, please consider volunteering to serve your church.

With more vaccinations now available it appears that the pandemic may soon be getting under control. We have taken every precaution to assure that our church will be safe when we reopen. Our last endeavor was the installation of the air purifying systems, so we feel we will be ready to reopen once everyone is vaccinated. So please get those vaccinations.
