Pastor's Message

Grace and peace be yours from God our Father and our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen

As I write this, I realize that we have entered the 11th month of the COVID-19 pandemic. So much has changed in our world that it's hard to keep up with everything.



One thing we can all rely on is God's love for us. In the midst of all of the change our Lord stays constant, constantly walking beside us, in front of us and behind us, constantly supporting us, listening to each prayer, drying our tears, and, in those times of joy, hearing our songs of thanksgiving. It's hard to imagine that a microscopic virus has forced our worship to take on such a completely different look and feel. But it's working. From recording the weekly Sunday service to celebrating Holy Communion in the parking lot each Tuesday we have risen to the challenge of meeting the spiritual needs of our Gloria Dei family. We are reaching more people with the Gospel of the Lord than we have in the past. On average, our internet outlets, YouTube and Facebook, receive over 160 views every week. According to the ELCA metric for calculating Sunday worship attendance, this means that we have more than 300 people in worship each week. And even though we can't be together physically for socializing, the Sunday Morning Virtual Coffee Hour has brought us closer together and in a much different, and in some ways, deeper way than before.

There was some concern voiced during our recent congregational meeting that we should return to in-person worship on Sunday mornings. However, when asked who would show up for in-person worship there were only about half a dozen folks who raised their hands. It seems that the council's decision to refrain from in-person worship until the numbers of new cases and deaths from this disease start to decline considerably is shared by a majority of the people.

The leadership of this congregation is and has always been concerned first and foremost with the safety and health of our family. To date, there has only been one case of COVID-19 reported throughout our congregation. I believe that this is because we have been faithful in keeping contact to a minimum. Every time we ignore proper mask and social distancing protocols, we put others in harm's way. Thanks to all of you who understand that we must stay vigilant in our fight against this virus. May God bless us now and always. See you in church on the internet and in the parking lot. *-Pastor Jim*

Council Corner for January 2021 By William Birdsall, council president

The Church council has been continuing its meetings and hard work and is dealing with various issues and solving them in a timely manner. We just had our annual congregational meeting this last Sunday, January 24, where we re-elected three existing council members but had no candidates for the fourth vacancy. This leaves us short one council member and that position needs to be filled. Please, if you think you are at all interested in serving on the Council, let me know.

The congregation also approved the 2021 Mission spending plan, but, as Linda Hide, our treasurer, stressed at the meeting, we need to increase our giving for 2021 to support the costs of our future new full-time pastor. Last year we asked that everyone increase their giving by 10% to show we could support the cost of a fulltime pastor, but we fell short. Please try to support this year's Spending Plan.

We were unable to find a volunteer to serve as a Maintenance supervisor to manage maintenance work of the church building interior and exterior. After much consideration, the Council choose to hire Bob Keim, our present outdoor grounds keeper, to perform the duties of the maintenance supervisor. He will work under the Council's supervision to perform minor repairs and oversee work performed by outside contractors.

After the recent robbery of equipment from our shed we had two additional security cameras installed on the exterior of the church, one at the front entrance and one at the rear of the building directed at the storage sheds. We will also be adding additional lighting directed at the sheds and at the front of the building within the next month.

Finally, as we all know, the pandemic is getting worse and not better. The original projections for vaccine availability have fallen short of their goals and the situation doesn't appear to be getting any better soon. Also, with new strains of COVID-19 popping up around the world and in our country, no one can really predict when the virus will be under control. With that being said, the Council still feels that we are not in a position to open up the church to Sunday service for the near future. We review this situation at every Council meeting, basing our decision on local, county, state, and county-wide information. We are committed to assuring the safety of our congregation and pastor before we make the decision to reopen in-person services.
