

## ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN BIBLICAL STUDIES COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

BI101	Old Testament Survey	A survey of the Old Testament through the book of Malachi.
BI102	New Testament Survey	A Survey of the New Testament through the book of Revelation.
RS100	Power Principles	Power principles taught in this course will enable you to experience the spiritual power taught in the Bible. This course answers the heart cry of those who have hungered for reality instead of religion. It will move you from being a spectator to a demonstrator of the power of God.
EVAN101	Leaven-Like Evangelism	Designed to mobilize and equip believers to fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ to take the Gospel of the Kingdom of God to every creature. It is divided into three sections. <b>Part One</b> focuses on the mandate given by Jesus to preach the Gospel of the Kingdom of God to all creatures. <b>Part Two</b> focuses on the healing and deliverance ministry that is to accompany the preaching and teaching of the Gospel. <b>Part Three</b> focuses on the pattern of church planting.
CED112	Biblical Management Principles	This study presents principles of management revealed in God's written Word, the Holy Bible. "Management" is another word for "stewardship." "Stewards," or "managers," are responsible over something entrusted to them by someone else. As believers, each of us are managers of spiritual resources with which God has entrusted us.
CC101	Introduction to Christian Counseling	Christian counseling is as old as are the needs of men for direction. It is best called teaching, mentoring, comforting, encouraging, and correcting. The more biblically centered counseling is the more Christian based it becomes. The purpose of this course is to further enable students to be a better servant in comforting, healing, and instructing people who cry out for help.
BTH106	Basic Doctrines I	This course is an introduction and overview of the basic bible doctrines of Scripture, God, Satan, Man, and Sin.

BTH107	Basic Doctrines II	This course is a continuation of Basic Doctrines I and cover the doctrines of Christ, Angels, the Church, Holy Spirit, Heaven, Hell, and Eschatology. These studies become the basis of establishing a biblical worldview.
CED101	Teaching Tactics	In "Teaching Tactics" you will learn how to use a great spiritual weapon. That weapon is the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God (Ephesians 6:17). You will learn tactics of preaching and teaching God's Word for the purpose of defeating the enemy. This course uses God's Word, the Holy Bible, as the revelation upon which all teaching is based. In Biblical teaching the teacher, subject, and methods must all be in harmony with the Bible.
RS110	Spiritual Warfare Strategies	To be effective in spiritual warfare, we need to know these spiritual strategies and how to put them into action. It is for this reason that "Strategic Spiritual Warfare" has been written. Instead of just learning about spiritual warfare, you will begin to do warfare through a 15-step interactive program that will guide you in facing the battles of life.
BPA111	Foundations of Faith	Includes Studying for Success and an introduction to the doctrines of Christ-centered Faith. Suggested textbook - <i>You are Destined to Win</i> - John Chacah.
RS111	Kingdom Living	This course deals with the concepts of living by the laws and principles of the Kingdom of God.
BPA112	Developing Intimacy with God	This course endeavors to explore "knowing God" in a personal, Intimate way through His Word, The Holy Spirit and using Jesus' relationship with the Father as our perfect example.
BPA132	Intercessory Prayer	In this study you will learn what intercessory prayer is and how to do it effectively using dynamic spiritual resources that have been delegated for this purpose. You will learn what to pray for, how to overcome hindrances to intercessory prayer, and how to get started and keep going.

BI201	The Gospel of John	The fourth Gospel is studied in light of its historical context and its stated evangelistic purpose to discover its testimony of the deity of the Lord Jesus Christ and to his saving work. The course will also explain and demonstrate some basic interpretative principles and methods of Bible study.
RS205	Knowing God's Voice	This course explains how God speaks to man and how to find God's will for your life. Guidelines are given on knowing the voice of God and determining His will. The pattern of God's will and Scriptural examples of how God reveals His will are discussed.
LEAD210	Leadership	A study on the biblical qualifications for leadership, important keys to success as a leader, and timeless leadership principles that serve as a basis for a person's ministry as a leader.
BPA211	Creative Bible Study Methods	Introduces the Bible as the written Word of the one true God. It explains divisions of the Bible, versions, translations, and paraphrases. CBSM explains how to outline, make study notes, mark your Bible for easy reference, and reduce lengthy passages to simple charts. This course guides you to proper interpretation and application of God's Word.
RS211	History of Christianity	In the 2,000 years since the birth of the Church, much has happened. It is in the best interest of the believer to understand the different periods of our religious history.
BPA261	Local Church	A study of the local church in God's eternal purpose including a practical emphasis on the biblical pattern, the structure, and the ministries that make up and contribute to the successes of the local church today.
