**Course Schedule**

<b>Week</b>	<b>Topic</b>	<b>Brief Description</b>
1	Sharing the Gospel	Students learn how to clearly communicate the message of salvation through word, lifestyle, and personal testimony, with emphasis on evangelism rooted in wisdom, boldness, and compassion.
2	Relating to Authority	Explores biblical authority structures in the home, church, and society, highlighting submission, accountability, and God’s order for healthy relationships.
3	Marriage and Family	Examines God’s design for marriage and family life, focusing on unity, love, biblical roles, and discipleship within the home.
4	Understanding the Church	Provides a biblical understanding of the church as the Body of Christ, including its purpose, function, and spiritual significance.
5	Building Authentic Community	Focuses on developing Christ-centered relationships marked by unity, fellowship, accountability, and mutual support within the body of Christ.
6	Church Membership and Commitment	Teaches the importance of faithful church membership, service, submission, and commitment to the local church.

<b>Week</b>	<b>Topic</b>	<b>Brief Description</b>
7	The Heart of a Servant	Highlights servant leadership modeled by Christ, emphasizing humility, obedience, and faithfulness in ministry.
8	Christian Stewardship	Covers biblical principles of stewardship related to time, talents, finances, and resources, encouraging responsible and faithful living.
9	Fulfilling Your Ministry	Helps students identify their calling, spiritual gifts, and purpose, equipping them to walk faithfully in their God-given ministry assignment.
10	Gifts of the Spirit	Introduces the spiritual gifts, their purpose in the church, and the importance of operating in them with love, maturity, and biblical order.
11	Worship	Explores worship as a lifestyle, emphasizing worship in spirit and truth through obedience, reverence, and daily devotion.
12	Living as a Disciple	Concludes with a call to lifelong discipleship, spiritual growth, and consistent Christ-like living beyond the classroom.
