*Gathering on March 30, 2019 with 9 (nine) other churches and organizations met with discussions including congregational needs for the community, activities of other churches, our need for drivers to deliver Meals On Wheels and Congregational Church had extra drivers

to assist us, and working jointly on future endeavors. Further discussion for future gatherings possibly May or June. Communication was begun to reach out via e-mail exchange. The first gathering was captured in the Journal and hopefully this will encourage more churches to participate.



LIGHTNING AND KINDNESS by Peter Burchard (as told to Mike Skibbe)

Following a tragic incident in 1906, members of your church (Christ Church) cared for my great-grandmother, the boy who would become my grandfather and his siblings. I attribute the work of your church to my presence today and the power of the gospel. I was able to locate a document my dad wrote in 1993 in which he summarized a bit of family history in Des Plaines (at least the parts he decided to remember.) Following a tragedy in 1906, your church provided my ancestors with a house - a home. Others in Des Plaines also helped "this destitute family." I suppose I am here today, along with my siblings, because of how your church family took care of mine. Further, isn't it amazing that Mike and I would come to know each other and this would lead to sharing a story of love and goodness from 113 years ago. God's generational grace is indescribable. I'm unsure how to say "thank you" for what the church at Cora and Henry did for my great-grandmother, the young boy who would become my grandfather and his siblings. As I think about how this may have unfolded, I'm teary-eyed. Thank You Christ Church.
